- Old Business - Web site not up yet. Fountain programming will be setting up the site at a cost of \$1,600.00. They are redesigning the site. The domain name was not renewed in January. Carol Holden spoke about proposal that was not acted upon, so site not up. Ray Valdes paid \$9.21 to GoDaddy.com on 6/7/07 for the domain name.

- Dennis Hollingsworth asked that there be more coordination with all officers regarding the website and newsletter. Not enough communication and organization within NCRCO. Newsletter not coming out on regular basis. Carol spoke to this as well. Conference calls to be set up by Carol in the future.
